



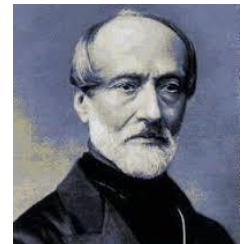
Summer Tasks for Year 12 History 2021

In order to prepare for Year 12 History, you need to complete the following tasks. Your work will be collected by your teacher in the second lesson back.

Italian Unification, 1789-1896

You will study the unification of Italy including the revolutions which paved the way for unification as well as the role of fascinating individuals such as Garibaldi, Mazzini and Cavour. In order to prepare for this, we would like you to:

- Research what Italy was like socially, economically and politically before Napoleon invaded in 1789 to create 10-point fact file
- Research and produce 5-point profiles on key figures in Unification: Garibaldi, Mazzini and Cavour.
- Research the lasting impact of the French Revolution on European monarchs

The Later Tudors, 1547-1603

- Produce a 10-point fact file about each of the main monarchs of the Tudor period: Henry VII, Henry VIII, Edward VI, Mary I and Elizabeth I
