Tasks for September 2023

1. To prepare for the **TECTONIC PROCESSES AND HAZARDS TOPIC**

Keep a detailed record of tectonic hazards, (earthquakes, volcanic eruptions and tsunamis) that happen over the summer break. You could keep this as a diary.

Include the date, time, location, and magnitude of the event, impact of the event on the people, environment and economy. This should include specific facts and you should quote the source of your information.

Good places to research are USGS (United States Geological Survey) website, the newspapers and the BBC website and news.

2. To prepare for the **COASTAL LANDSCAPES AND CHANGE TOPIC**

Research one coastal area; it may be one you have visited in the past or one you visit this summer holiday.

Find some images or photographs you have taken of the area. Annotate them with the following information:-

1. How is the area being used?
2. What is the natural landscape like?
3. How is this area being managed?

Complete the two tasks on different pieces of paper, as they will be marked by different teachers. Please bring these with you for your first Geography lesson in September.
