In order to prepare for Year 12 History, you need to complete the following tasks. They are not optional. Your work will be collected by your teacher in the second lesson back.

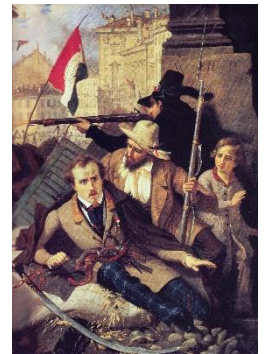


Italian Unification, 1789-1896

You will study the unification of Italy including the revolutions which paved the way for unification as well as the role of fascinating individuals such as Garibaldi, Mazzini and Cavour. In order to prepare for this, we would like you to:

- Research and create a fact-file about the states that existed in Italy before 1789: Piedmont, Lombardy, Venetia, Parma, Modena, Tuscany, Papal States, Naples and Sicily. You should include who each state was ruled by, the economic situation of the state and what the state was known for.
- Research and make one side of notes/ a key information sheet on what the French Revolution was and how this impacted European monarchs in the period 1789-1815.
- Make notes on the video 'What caused Italian Unification'
